Time Expressions with Reported Speech Sometimes when we change direct speech into reported speech we have to change time expressions too We don't always have to do this, however It depends on when we heard the direct speech and when we say the reported speech For example: It's Monday Julie says "I'm leaving today"

### **Direct and Indirect Speech - English Grammar**

In indirect speech, words spoken by one person is reported in another place at a different time by a different person Because of this, there are many grammatical differences between direct and indirect speech It is not necessary to learn complicated rules about indirect speech in English, because most of the changes are natural and logical
